Trump Campaign Economic Advisor: NAFTA Withdrawal Would Create “Great Harm” For Agriculture & Energy Sectors

Trump Campaign Senior Economic Adviser & CNBC Senior Contributor Larry Kudlow: “Look. My eyes are open and we’ve talked about this. I want them to stay and negotiate. A withdrawal, an abrupt withdrawal from [North American Free Trade Agreement] NAFTA, which I don’t frankly think the President is going to do, but that kind of abrupt withdrawal, will have great harm I think to the stock market, I think, which would frankly blow up on that kind of news. It would create great harm to our relations. It would [create] great harm to business confidence, agriculture, and energy and car parts. You know, nowadays, it’s an integrated economy, you’re not going to disintegrate the economy. Supply chains are going to go on whether you want NAFTA to do it or not. Trucks are going to go cross-border whether you have NAFTA or not. So, you’re just going to have chaos, just lawlessness – that’s the weirdest thing.
